FIRE SEASON is coming up quickly - BE PREPARED by Don Florence

Last year was another volatile year with several large destructive fires statewide and another large fire here in Mariposa County. Last years Ferguson fire tested the professional abilities of our First Responders and the community's abilities on quick evacuations. The time to think about fire and its destructive nature is NOW. Make your house defensible against not just the flames impinging on the structures but also the massive ember showers that happens up to a mile from the fire front. These embers can cause flammable items around your house to ignite and cause damage. Think about a plan in case you have to leave your house given 15 minutes, 2 hours and 8 hours time frames. If there is no power or phones have a plan on where will you meet or connect with other family members. If you're not signed up for the emergency notification system through the Sheriffs department now is the time.
